

Robert Zivadinov, M.D., Ph.D., is a professor of neurology with tenure at the Department of Neurology, School of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences, University of Buffalo, State University of New York and honorary professor of neurology at the University of Sidney, Australia. He is director of the Buffalo Neuroimaging Analysis Center and of the Center for Biomedical Imaging at the Clinical Translational Research Center. He has performed extensive research in multiple sclerosis and other neurodegenerative disorders, having published more than 420 articles and 750 abstracts in leading peer-reviewed journals with H-index of 72.
