

**Paolo Zamboni, MD.**

Professor, Chair of Vascular Surgery and Program Director of the School of Vascular Surgery, University of Ferrara, Italy.

Dr. Zamboni is Chair of the Vascular Disease Center, and of the Regional Hub Centre for Venous and Lymphatic Disorders at the University Hospital of Ferrara, Italy. Dr. Zamboni first discovered the chronic cerebrospinal venous insufficiency (CCSVI) in patients with multiple sclerosis. He is the past president of ISNVD and the founder of ISNVD. He received the Gold Medal at ISNVD'2015. Dr. Zamboni also won Annete Funniceo Award in 2016 for Neurosciences and San Giorgio Gratitude Award of the Town of Ferrara in 2016. He is author of 250 publications with H-Index 48 and more than 11.000 citations. His research interest has been focused on the pathophysiology, hemodynamics, diagnosis and treatment of abnormal cerebral venous and lymphatic drainage.
