

SALVATORE J.A. SCLAFANI, M.D., FSIR

Dr. Sclafani is a Diplomate of the American College of Radiology and Vascular and Interventional Radiology. Professor of Radiology, Surgery and Emergency Medicine at SUNY Downstate until 2011, he is currently Emeritus Professor of Radiology at that University.

Since leaving the medical school in 2011, he has developed a clinical practice of interventional radiology in an outpatient environment so that he could return to full-time patient care. He currently is an associate at Azura Vascular Care where he focuses his clinical research on the diagnosis and treatment of symptomatic obstructions of the cerebrovascular veins while having a robust practice of vascular interventions for women's diseases.

He is a Founder of and Past President for the International Society for Neurovascular Disease, past President and co-Founder of the American Society of Emergency Radiology, a Fellow of the Society of Interventional Radiology, and the first international member of the Chinese Society of Interventional Radiology.

Dr. Sclafani, as an innovator in trauma care, has authored nearly 150 scientific papers and authored or co-authored more than 20 textbooks. He was the first Section Editor of Radiology for the *Journal of Trauma and* served on the editorial boards of the *Journal of Interventional Radiology*, and *Emergency Radiology*. He recently joined the editorial board of the newly founded Journal of Interventional Medicine.
